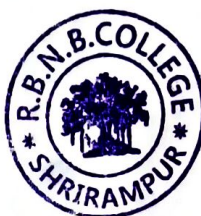
**Feedback Analysis Report on curriculum collected from different stakeholders**

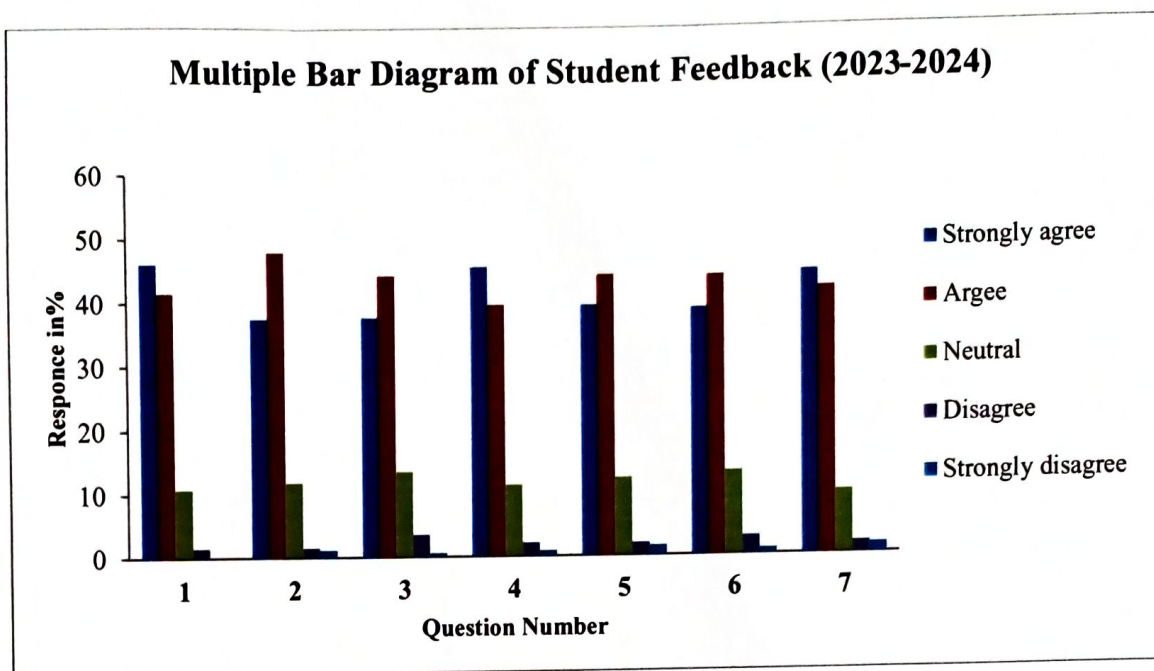
**Academic Year: 2023-2024**

**Students Feedback:**

The students are the most important stakeholders of Higher Education systems. The interest and participation of students at all the levels in both internal quality assurance and external quality assurance plays a central role. We have collected online feedback from our under graduate students and post graduate students. A special five-point scale feedback form on the curriculum was designed by the college. We have received total 592 student's online feedback on the syllabus of the various programmes offered by the college. The responses in percentage for each question are given in the following table.

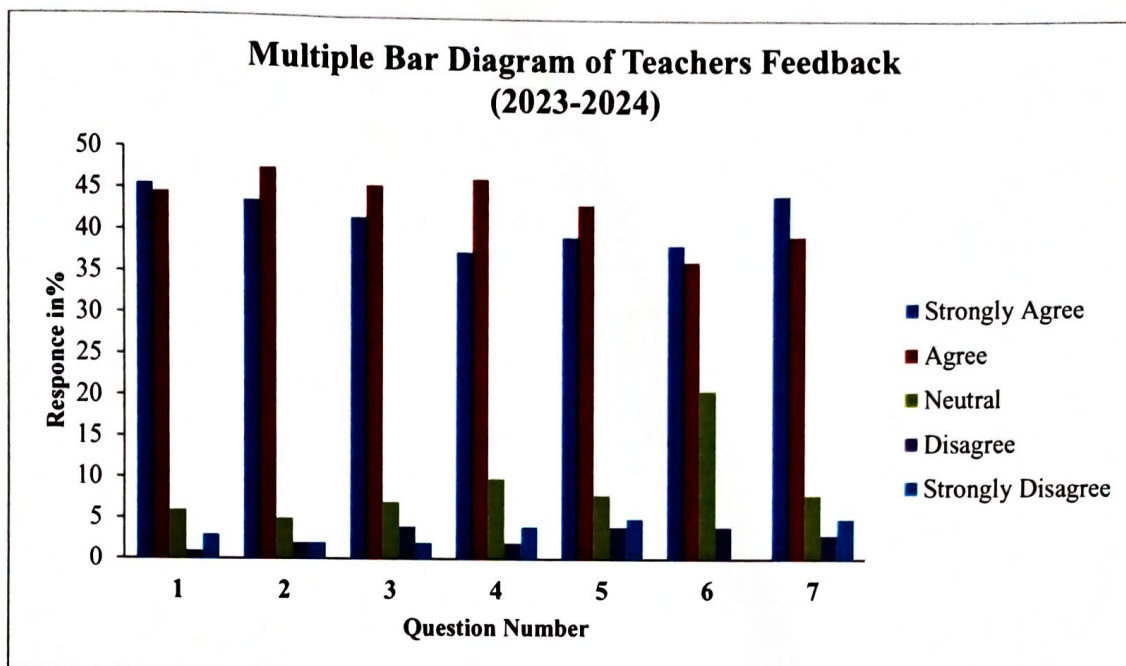
### Teachers Feedback:

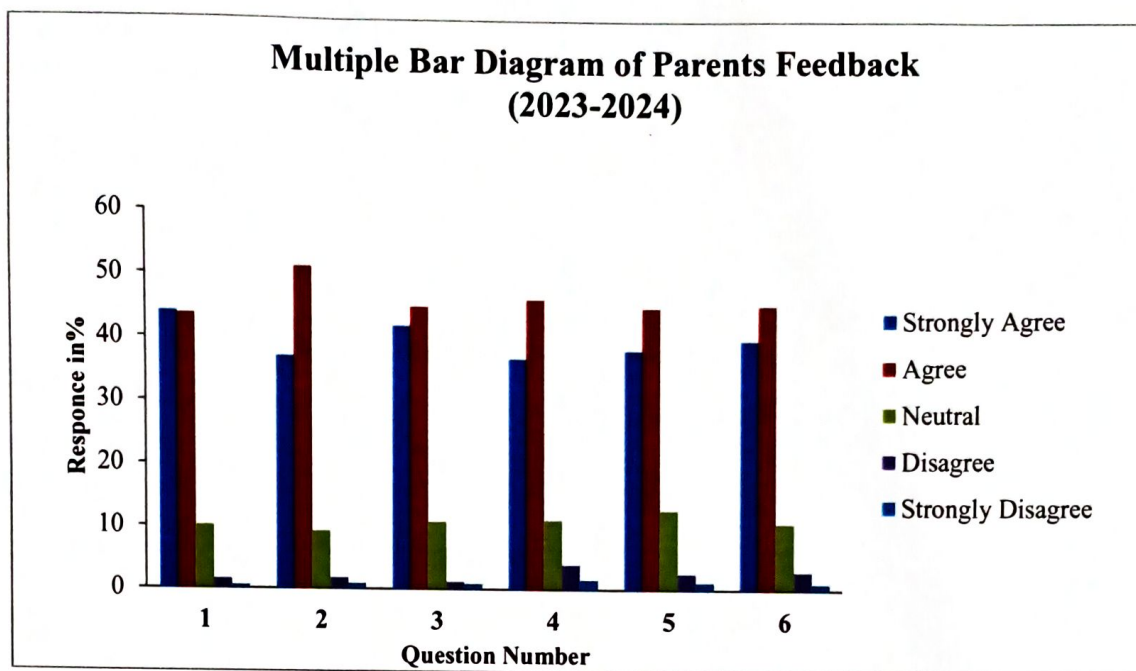

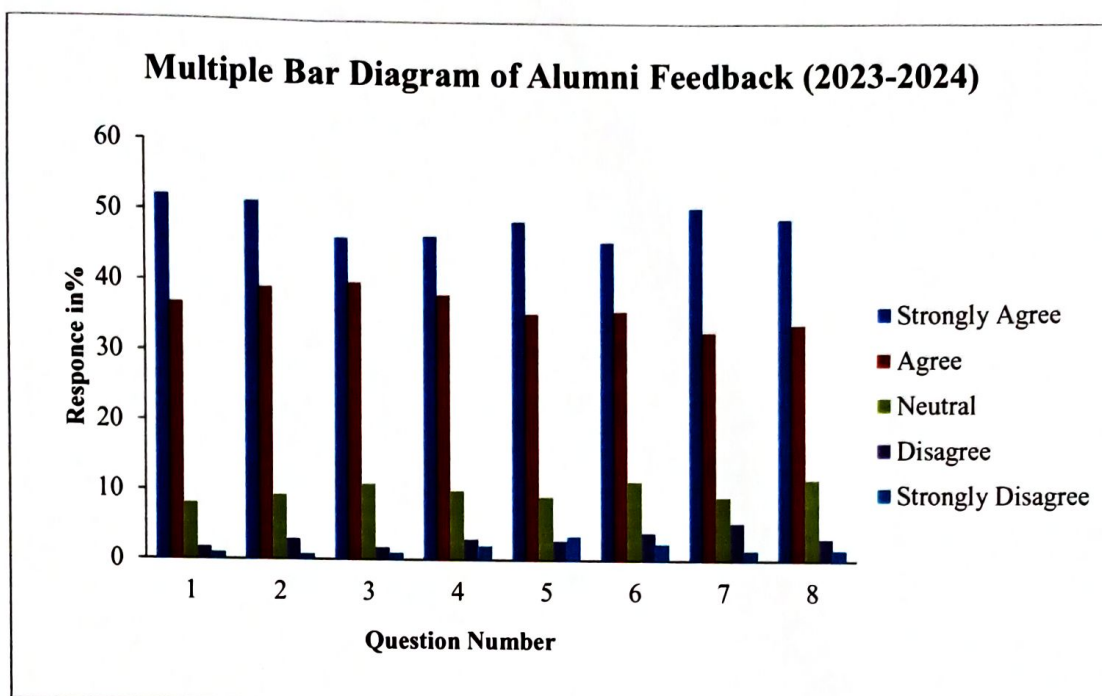

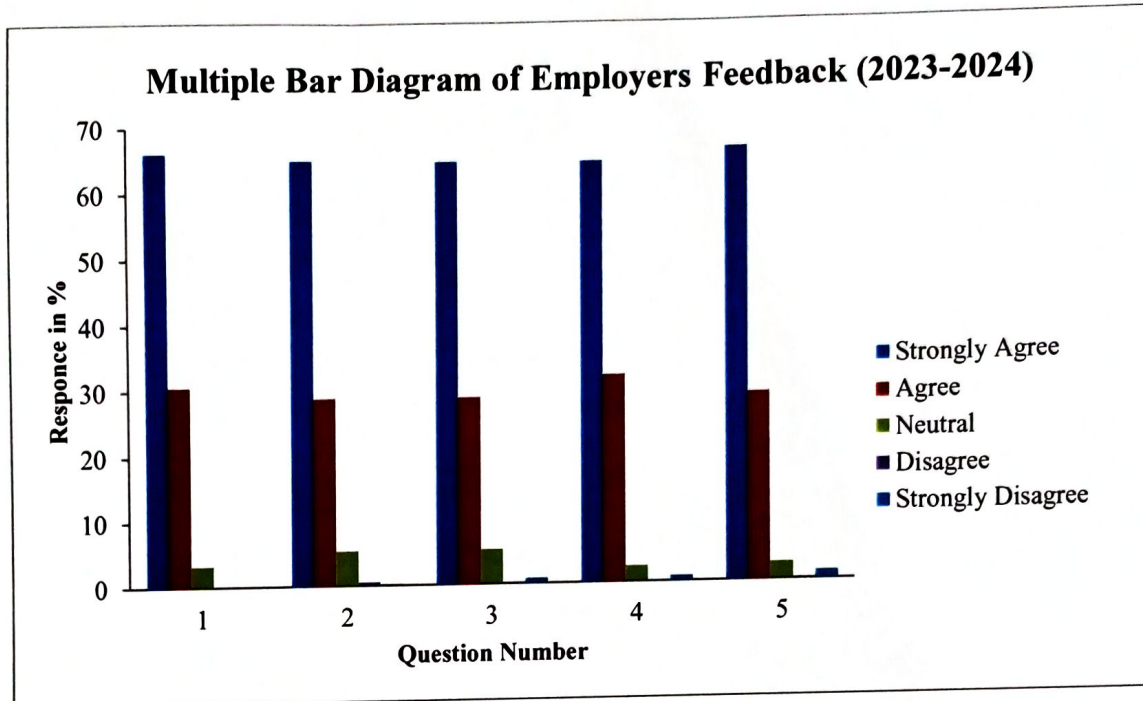
### Employers Feedback:
