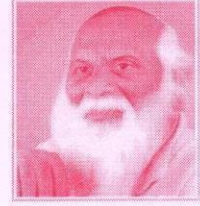



## Report of Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum

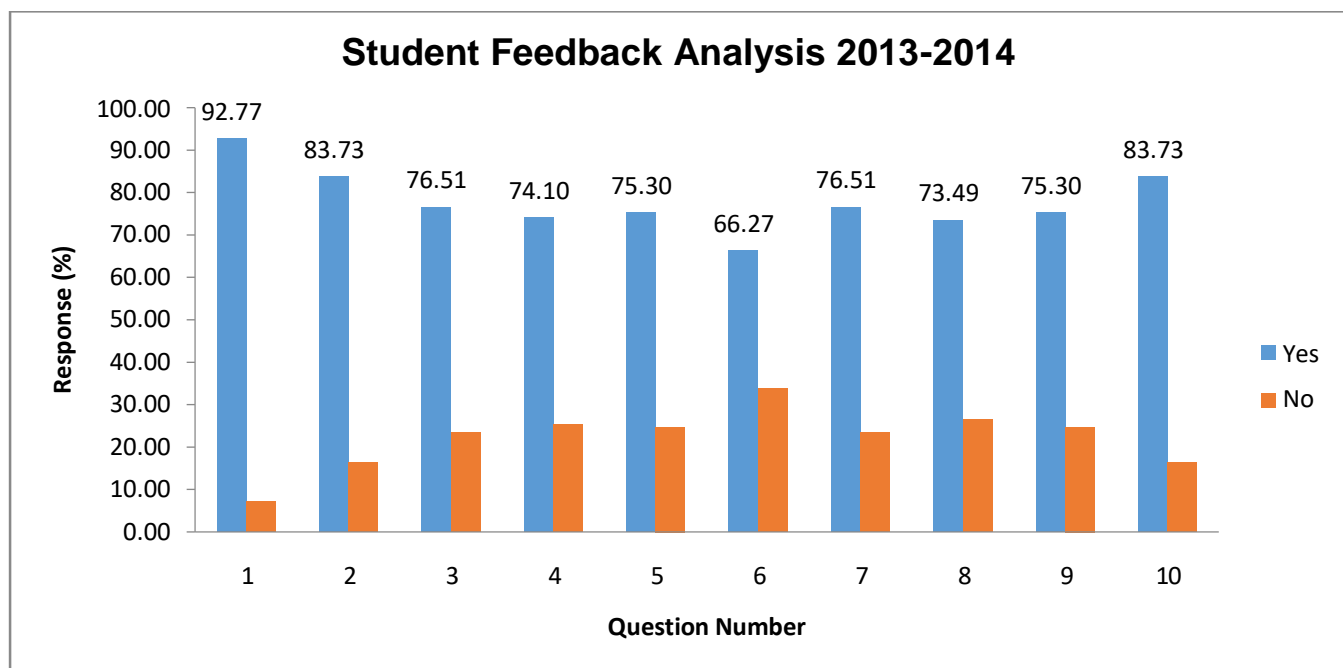
Academic Year: 2013-2014

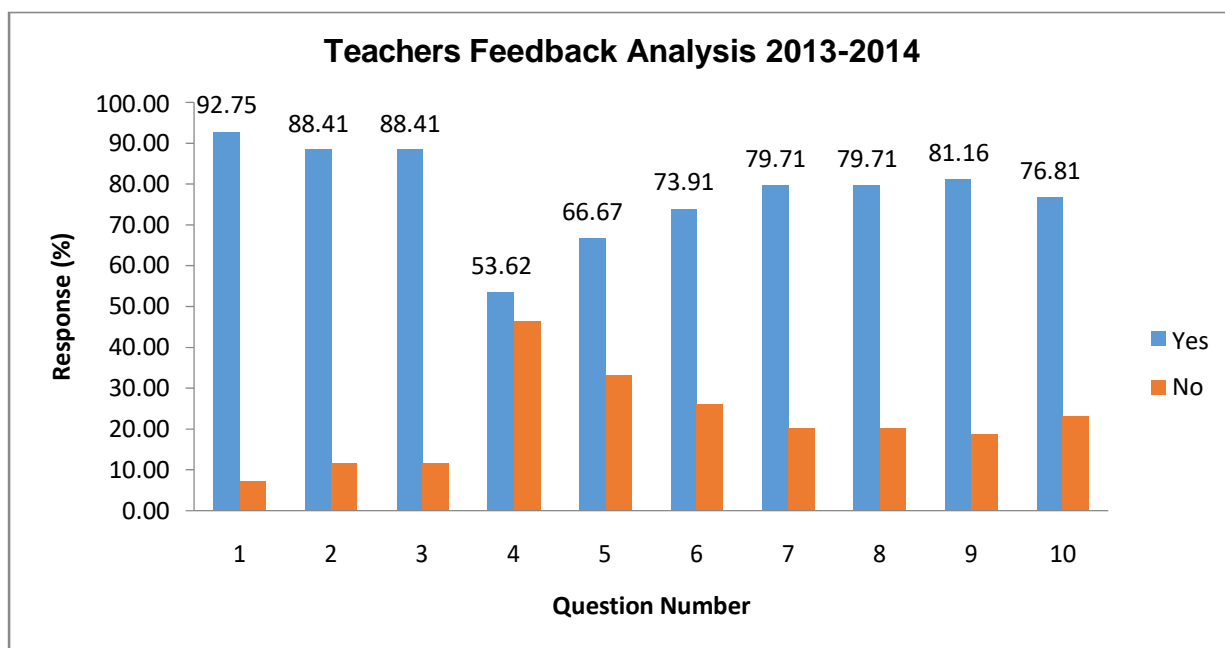

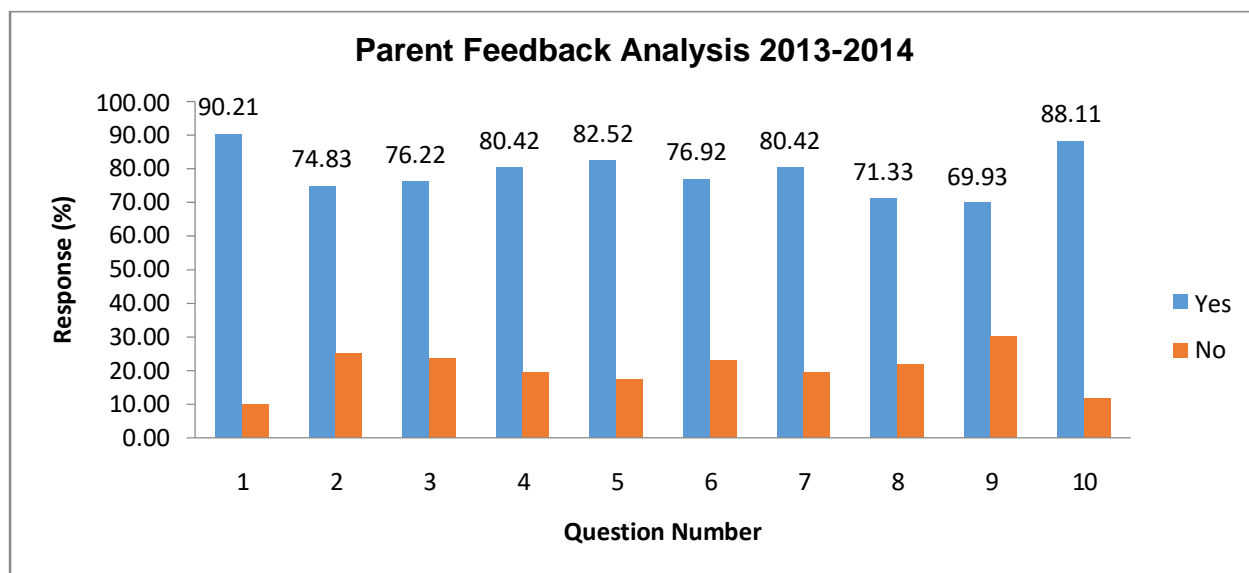

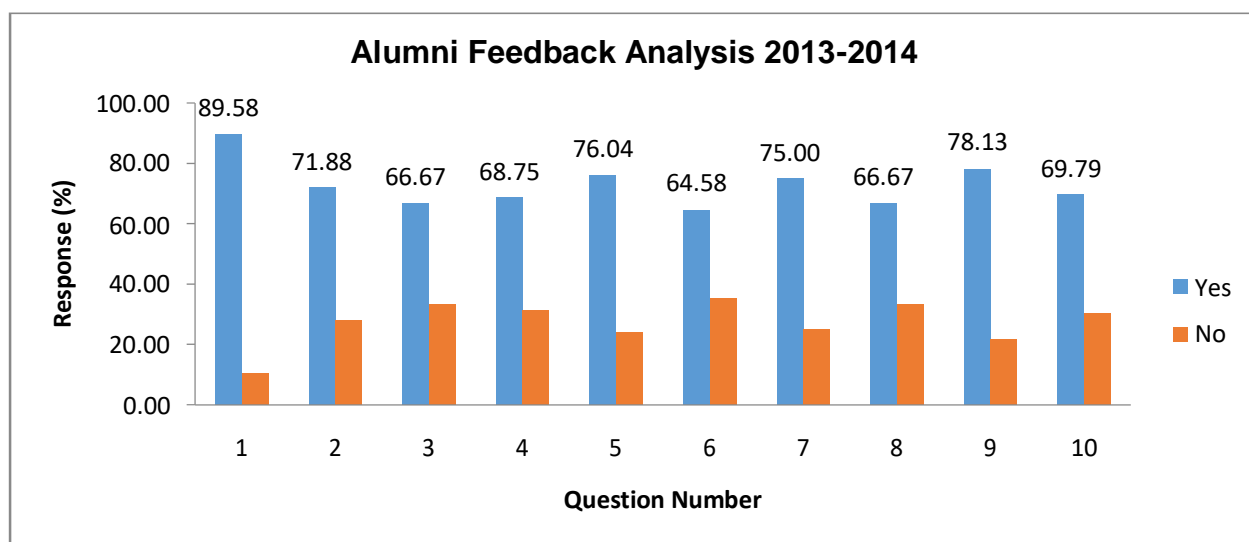
From the above diagram it is observed that the on an average 79% parents are satisfied with the current content of the syllabus designed by Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

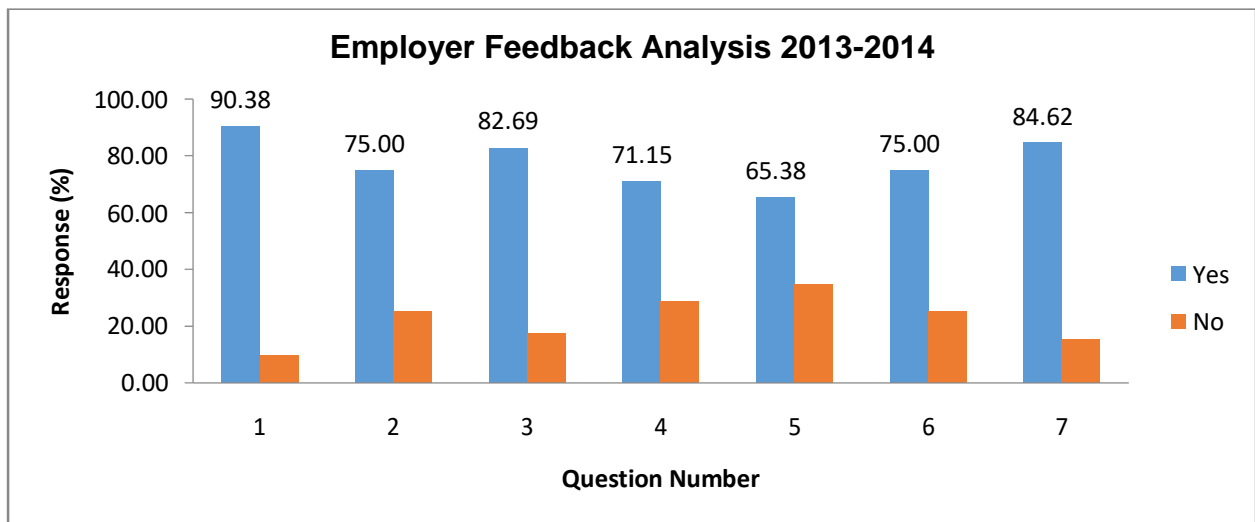
