Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara is a premier educational institution acknowledged globally for its variety of impetus. The institution itself is regarded as a noble mission, a noble cause, so earnestly and so endearingly pursued by its founder- father Late Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil, the educator of the educators and his legendary wife Sou. Laxmibai Patil with her exemplary sacrifices made to turn the mission into a reality. Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil had an incisive understanding of the social ills that beset his times and fully realized the dire need of the spread of education. He believed that education alone could correct the social ills such as caste-hierarchy, money-lending, illiteracy, untouchability, superstitions and social and economic inequality. 
- College ensures clean and hygienic campus
