MBBS (Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery)-

BPT Eligibility Criteria

Students who have completed their 10 +2 education with science as their major subject are eligible to apply for Bachelor of Physiotherapy course. The candidate should have pursued the Science stream with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as their main subjects. A Minimum aggregate score of 50% or equivalent at 10+2 level is mandatory for admission. Some universities in India conduct an entrance test for admitting students for the BPT course. Some of these entrance examinations are CET, JIPMER all India entrance test, Guru Govind Indraprastha University Physiotherapy entrance exam, etc.

- There are 47 BVSC colleges in India which include Indian Veterinary Research Institute, College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences, CSKHPKV, etc.
- BVSc course is ideal for candidates who consider themselves as animal lovers and want to work or own an animal breeding and caring firm and want to establish a <u>career in animal husbandry</u>.
- According to the latest guidelines from the Veterinary Council of India, BVSc course duration should be of 5.5 years divided into 10 semesters and 1 year of compulsory internship.
- AIPVT was replaced by NEET in 2017 for admission to <u>veterinary pharmacy courses</u> and <u>veterinary medicine</u> courses in India.
- Any candidate who has completed Class 12 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as compulsory subjects, along with English from a recognized board is eligible to apply for <u>BVSc Admission 2021</u>.
- BVSc syllabus covers everything from animal anatomy and physiology to treatment and surgery of animals.
 The major BVSc subjects are animal nutrition, animal breeding, and genetics, animal pathology, among others.
- After BVSc, ample job opportunities are available in Agriculture Sectors, Government Animal, Defense Dog training centers, Zoological Parks, Aviaries, Wildlife Sanctuaries, etc., with an average starting salary of INR 3.6 LPA.
