
# हिंदी दिन समारोह (२०२१-२०२२)





Department of Marathi, R. B. Narayanrao Borawake College, Shrirampur visited to Sarvadnya Vidyapeeth (University), at Malwadgaon, Tal: Shrirampur, Dist: Ahmednagar and Domegram (Kamalpur, Tal: Shrirampur) on 05/02/2022. The purpose of Educational Excursion was to learn about Mahanubhava (also known as Jai Krishni Pantha) refers to Krishnaite Hindu denomination in India that was founded in 12<sup>th</sup> Century by Sarvadnya Shri Chakradhar Swami, who is considered as a reincarnation of Lord Krishna.

The college students took interest in numerous treatises authored by Mahanubhava scholars that describe about the five incarnations of God.
